

## Course registration and conditions

Please register in writing by email or registration form. Registration is considered to be binding (**course reference: K8**). You will receive a confirmation in good time before the beginning of the course. The course fee can be paid in cash or by card during the course itself.

If the course is already fully booked, you will be informed of this as soon as possible.

An administrative fee of CHF 60 is charged if you cancel up to four weeks prior to the beginning of the course. A fee of CHF 100 is charged for cancellations less than four weeks in advance.

In the event of short-term cancellation (3 days before start of course or less), you will be charged the full course fee (excl. board and accommodation). If you fail to show up for the course without advance cancellation, you will be charged the entire amount (course fee incl. board and accommodation). No cancellation fees are charged if you organize someone else to take your place in the course.

We assume that you will take part in the whole course and spend the night(s) at the Lassalle-Haus. There are no refunds for meals not taken during the course, belated arrival or early departure.

## How to get to the Lassalle-Haus Bad Schönbrunn

### By train and bus

By train from Zurich or Lucerne to Zug (trains every half hour). From Zug railway station take bus no. 2 in the direction of Menzingen and get off at Bad Schönbrunn (request stop), right in front of the Lassalle-Haus.

### By car

#### From the direction of Lucerne / Arth Goldau

Drive to the center of Zug up to Kolinplatz, then follow the signs to Ägeri/Menzingen. 500 m after the *Lorzentobelbrücke* bridge turn left in direction of Menzingen. After 300 m turn right into the Lassalle-Haus driveway.

#### From the direction of Zurich

Go in direction of Lucerne/Gotthard. At the roundabout in Sihlbrugg head for Neuheim/Ägeri/ Menzingen. In Edlibach turn right in direction of Zug. After ca. 1500 m turn left into the Lassalle-Haus driveway.

The core of all true religion and spirituality is neither the profession of specific tenets of faith, nor adherence to moral rules. Not accumulating ever more information, but a change of perspective and attitude is the road to wisdom. In a state of oneness, of pure being here and now, right and wrong, good and evil, and God and humans are no longer absolute opposites. By overcoming our innate tendency to think in dualistic terms, we begin to feel comfortable with paradoxes. Formerly rigid borderlines in our mind, which so often lead to aggression and violence, gradually dissolve. To attain the peace of mind we all aspire to, we need to learn to see what the mystics of all religions and ages have taught: All is ultimately one, and life is pure presence.

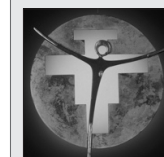
